It is difficult to believe that the first edition of this volume was published in 1998, which was 17 years ago. It was almost as popular as the 1887 jubilee medals catalogue, and quickly sold out and has been out of print for several years.

In those 17 years much has changed. Photography, printing and computers have all made great advances and we have fully taken advantage of those advances to present the user with indexes of obverse and reverse legends, makers, designers, die cutters and publishers, and an index of registered design numbers as well as a general index.

This new, improved and expanded edition, 133 pages, size A4 (204 x 297mm) with glossy laminated cover, is well-illustrated throughout with hundreds of high-quality black and white illustrations.
